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Dana Cup No.1

Frederikshavn

July 9-14, 2012

The Dana Cup No.1 is a cosy, familiar tournament where quality, closeness and camaraderie for the participants are focused.

As a participant in the Dana Cup No.1 you will play international youth football on excellent grass pitches.

The information centre and the dining hall are centrally located in the Arena Nord, which is in walking distance from the town centre, hotels, schools and football pitches.

The very first Dana Cup No.1 was played in Frederikshavn in 1984 with 130 youth football teams from 15 countries. Over the years, over 6,500 teams from 90 nations from every continent have participated!

AGE CATEGORIES

boys 11-players-a-side

B18: Boys born January 1st 1994 and later

B16: Boys born January 1st 1996 and later

B15: Boys born January 1st 1997 and later

B14: Boys born January 1st 1998 and later

B13: Boys born January 1st 1999 and later

boys 7-players-a-side

B12: Boys born January 1st 2000 and later

B11: Boys born January 1st 2001 and later

girls 11-players-a-side

G17: Girls born January 1st 1995 and later

G15: Girls born January 1st 1997 and later

G14: Girls born January 1st 1998 and later

G13: Girls born January 1st 1999 and later

girls 7-players-a-side

G12: Girls born January 1st 2000 and later

DISPENSATIONS

Dana Cup No.1 allows 3 overaged players (max. 1 year) per team but note that only 2 players are allowed to play in each match. In the 7-players-a-side, 2 overaged players (max. 1 year) are allowed but only 1 overaged player is allowed in each match. Please note that only 3 overaged players are allowed on the team squad/participants list.

AGE VERIFICATION

All teams must present a complete list of all the participating players. The list should be handed over at arrival together with valid identification for each participating player in good time before the first game.

Players that cannot show ID are not allowed to play in the tournament. You will receive all participants passes after this control.

PLAYERS and SUBSTITUTES

There are no limits to the number of players in a team but each team playing 11-a-side is entitled to use a maximum of 16 players per match.

Teams playing 7-a-side is entitled to use a maximum of 12 players. It is permitted to substitute and reinstate players except for the oldest age category B18.

REGULATIONS

The teams are divided into groups of four or five in which all play against each other. The standings between the teams will be decided by the number of points. A win results in three points, a draw in one point. If two or more teams have the same number of points the leading team is chosen in the following way:

1. Goal difference.
2. Highest number of goals scored.
3. Result from the match between the teams with the same points.
4. Penalty kicks contest according to FIFA regulations.

The two best teams in each group will advance to Play off A. The other teams in the group will go to the Play off B. All play off games will be decided by the cupsystem, i.e. by direct elimination.

RULES OF THE GAME

The Dana Cup No 1. is played in accordance with the DBU and FIFA regulations. All age categories except B12, B11 and G12 play with ball size 5, class, B12, B11 and G12 play with ball size 4. According to Danish rules all players must have shinguards. If a team fails to appear at two games all their previous results will be annulled. In questions of interpretations of FIFA rules, the English text applies.

COSTS

The entry fee is £ 155 per team. The fee is to be paid at the same time as the team register but no later than April 20th

The participation fee for those who will be staying at a school is £ 200 per participant, both players and leaders.

Teams that do not stay at a school pay the entry fee and a smaller participation fee of £50 per person. No food, transfer or shuttle buses is included in this cost.

PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fee includes:

- * Lodging at a school July 9th -14th
- * Transfer from the train station or harbour in Frederikshavn or from Aalborg Airport to the school the day of arrival and departure.
- * Free travels on the Dana Cup shuttle-buses.
- * 3 meals a day from dinner July 9th until lunch July 16th
- * Discount to the Dana Cup disco.

NB! Each participant must bring their own sleeping bag and air mattress or sleeping pad.

DEPOSIT

A room deposit of DKK 1,000 (approx. £100)/per team is paid at the school upon arrival. The amount will be refunded on departure after room check.

INSURANCES

It is very important every player makes sure that he or she is covered in case of injury.

In some cases players are covered by the club or by parents but it is the responsibility of the player not the tournament.

SPECIAL DIET

Players or leaders suffering of Celiac Disease/ Gluten intolerance or Lactose Intolerance have to be registered with full name and club.

The kitchen holds a special diets list. No name = no special diet.

If some person is extremely allergic, the dining hall cannot provide the necessary diet. If the participation fee already is paid, Dana Cup No.1 will refund a major part of it. NB! Please also note that if you by religious reasons don't eat pork, we need you to register on the list also.

SCHOOLS

Teams can request to stay in a certain school but no team is ever guaranteed to get the school they wish. The lodging depends of the number of participants in the team and the day of arrival and departure. Some schools are open one day before the tournament starts, some schools one day after the tournament closes.

At least one, but a maximum four leaders are allowed to stay with the team.

No parents, nor any little brothers or little sisters are allowed to stay at the school together with the team.

TRANSFERS

Dana Cup No.1 provides free transfer on the day of arrival- and the day of departure from the harbour in Frederikshavn, the train station in Frederikshavn or Aalborg Airport.

All teams that wish transfer have to book the transfer in advance. It is very important to give exact arrival and departure dates and times, otherwise Dana Cup No.1 cannot guarantee the transfer.

The Dana Cup-buses start on Monday July 9th and stop on Saturday July 14th. Buses are also provided every night after the disco to the schools.
